NJPN Members Form

The National Justice and Peace Network (NJPN) is a grass roots, lay-led Catholic organisation inspiring and supporting individuals and groups throughout England and Wales.

NJPN has three broad aims:

- ◆ to proclaim the vision of Justice and Peace and be a prophetic voice in the world
- ◆ to consolidate the unique network that is NJPN
- ◆ to maintain and develop links with the wider Church and Church based organisations

From its original core membership in 1978. of all 22 dioceses, NJPN now includes many Catholic/Christian organisations, religious orders and congregations.

An individual may be part of NJPN:-

By becoming a member with the right to vote*, stand for election to the Executive Committee** and receive reports from meetings.

Minimum subscription is £12 per annum (not eligible for Gift Aid).

*Only dioceses may vote on constitutional changes.
**Subject to attendance at a minimum of 2 meetings in 6.

By making an additional regular donation, eligible for Gift Aid, so contributing:

- ◆ To the development of NJPN's services to individuals, groups, and agencies within the Church
- ◆ to raising NJPN's profile throughout England and Wales
- ◆ to offering a model of how we can live out the gospel.

Currently, NJPN:

- ◆ supports a diocese or organisation to organise the annual conference, where four hundred activists from every diocese in England and Wales meet organisations, experts, and each other
- ◆ offers information via its website and newsletter
- ◆ holds 4 Networking Meetings a year around the country for support and exchange of information between dioceses, member organisations and individuals.
- ◆ provides a national point of contact for justice and peace issues
- ◆ facilitates twice yearly conferences for diocesan fieldworkers

NJPN develops a national dimension to Justice and Peace activities by:

- ◆ highlighting concerns for justice and peace in everyday life
- ◆ deepening justice spirituality within the Catholic tradition
- ◆ coordinating action
- ◆ spreading and sharing information and expertise regionally and nationally
- ◆ offering a structure for mutual support and encouragement
- ◆ strengthening links between the member organisations and their supporters
