Booking Terms and Conditions

1. Bookings are processed in the order they are received.
2. A booking is only accepted on receipt of the appropriate deposit.
3. Every effort is made to provide the type of room requested but this may not be possible due to limited accommodation.
4. **Low Income rate is heavily subsidised and is intended for those who would otherwise be unable to attend.**
5. A discount of 5% may be claimed by families including up to 2 adults and children aged 3-18. (No charge for under 3).
6. Conference participants are requested to pay the balance due on their booking by the 1st June 2024.
7. Cancellations after 15th June 2024 will be liable for the basic accommodation costs unless the place can be filled.
8. Non-attenders who have failed to pay in full will also be liable for the basic accommodation costs.
9. **Each Adult booking received after 15th May 2024 will be subject to a surcharge of £20.00** (does not apply to one day non-residents).

Please note that there are a limited number of spaces this year so we urge you to book as soon as possible!

As mentioned on the form, bookings after the 15th May incur a booking surcharge.
