### MEALS AT CONFERENCE

This year, there will be a choice of meat or vegetarian at all meals. We would encourage you to choose the vegetarian option if you can, following our environmental principles and in the main being better for the planet.

We do ask, though, that you make it clear when booking if you will be following a Vegetarian diet so that we can pass the information onto the Hayes.

Please also advise when booking of any dietary intolerances to enable the Hayes to cater adequately for you.

### Booking Terms and Conditions

1. Bookings are processed in the order they are received.
2. A booking is only accepted on receipt of the appropriate deposit.
3. Every effort is made to provide the type of room requested but this may not be possible due to limited accommodation.
4. **Low Income rate is heavily subsidised and is intended for those who would otherwise be unable to attend.**
5. A discount of 5% may be claimed by families including up to 2 adults and children aged 3-18. (No charge for under 3).
6. Conference participants are requested to pay the balance due on their booking by the 1st June 2026.
7. **Cancellations after 15th June 2026** will be liable for the basic accommodation costs unless the place can be filled.
8. Non-attenders who have failed to pay in full will also be liable for the basic accommodation costs.
9. **Each Adult booking received after 15th May 2026 will be subject to a surcharge of £20.00**
