Speakers



Revd Deirdre Brower Latz has worked as a pastor in urban/marginalised communities in Bristol and Manchester, and lectures at the Nazarene Theological College in Manchester.



Professor Anthony Reddie is the leading scholar in the practice of Black theology in grassroots communities of faithful practice.

We will also hear inspiring and challenging stories from churches and groups that are living out the vision of a ‘church of the poor’ – being church on the margins of our society. (Speakers and chair for this session to be confirmed soon.)

Children and young people

Children and young people are a vital part of the NJPN conference. There will be a crèche for children under 5 and a programme of activities for 5–11-year-olds. 12–18-year-olds will explore the conference theme in an active and thought-provoking weekend.

NJPN is committed to the protection of children, young people and vulnerable people. People of all ages and backgrounds are welcome and encouraged to attend conference.

Our rates for children and people on low incomes are subsidised. We count on the generous donations of those who can afford a little extra to make that possible.

Workshops

There will be workshops from a range of organisations and speakers, all looking creatively at how our churches can be more open to people on the margins.

Travel

A coach service is provided between the conference centre and Derby railway station on Friday evening and Sunday afternoon for £7 each way.

We will arrange car shares where possible.

Meals

Meals at NJPN conferences incorporate some LOAF principles (Locally sourced, Organically produced, Animal-friendly, Fairly traded). A meat option will be offered at the Saturday evening meal, but all other meals will be vegetarian.

- Bookings are processed in the order they are received.
- A booking is only accepted on receipt of the appropriate deposit.
- Owing to limited accommodation, families with older children may be placed in adjacent rooms.
- Low-income rate is subsidised and is intended for those who would otherwise be unable to attend.
- A discount of 5% may be claimed by families including up to 2 adults and children aged 3-18.
- Conference participants are requested to pay the balance due on their booking by Wednesday 19 June 2019.
- Cancellations after 19 June 2019 will be liable for the basic accommodation costs unless the place can be filled.
- Non-attenders who have failed to pay in full will also be liable for the basic accommodation costs.
- Adult bookings received after 17 May 2019 will be subject to a surcharge of £7.50 (unless booking for Saturday only).
